

# Impact Nailer

---

1. Operate only with instructors permission and appropriate supervision.
2. Wear Safety glasses and ear protection when using this machine.
3. Keep your finger OFF the trigger when not nailing. If you bump the nose piece with trigger depressed it will fire a nail.
4. Always keep the nailer pointed down and away from people when not in use.
5. Be careful when connecting and disconnecting nailers from power sources or compressed air.
6. Keep hands and feet at least double the fastener length away from the tip (so a 3" nail needs 6" clearance).
7. Place the nose piece or pad on the surface before pulling the trigger.
8. Always nail straight into the work, not at an angle.
9. Disconnect from power source before fixing a jam, replacing fasteners or other malfunctions. Nailer may discharge as soon as problem has been fixed.
10. Immediately quit using tool if the safety lock sticks or anything seems to be malfunctioning.
11. Check tool for problems before using.
12. If powered by compressed air, only use regulated air and be sure it does not exceed the recommended pressure for that tool.
